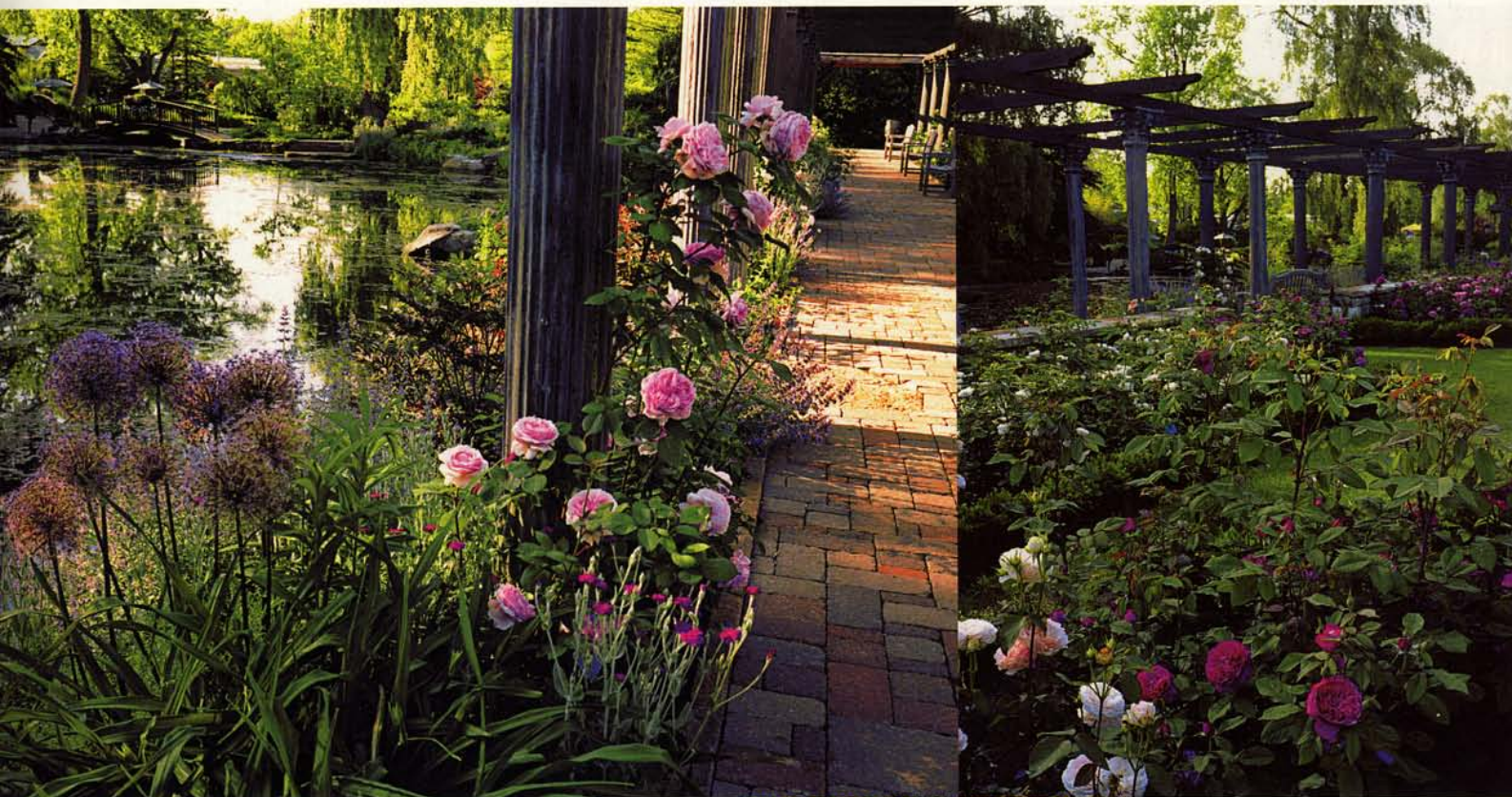


Three for the Road

THE BLOSSOMS AND FRAGRANCE of **Matterhorn Nursery's** three-acre David Austin Rose Garden in Rockland County, New York—the only such public display garden outside the United Kingdom—never fail to intoxicate. The roses are on show with abandon and for sale in abundance. And, in this four-year-old, resplendently lush garden, there's always a rosarian around who's willing to reveal a feeding formula or pruning technique. Since David Austin roses are repeat bloomers, this garden's beauty lasts all summer.

For the less rose-addicted, Matterhorn boasts 35 additional acres of imaginative display gardens, woodland ponds, greenhouses, and a gardener's village of shops of every variety. This is garden shopping as theater, topped off with an extensive selection of choice perennials, trees, shrubs, aquatics, annuals, herbs, roses, outdoor furniture, gifts, books, cut flowers, and a connoisseur's collection of tools and supplies. ▶
