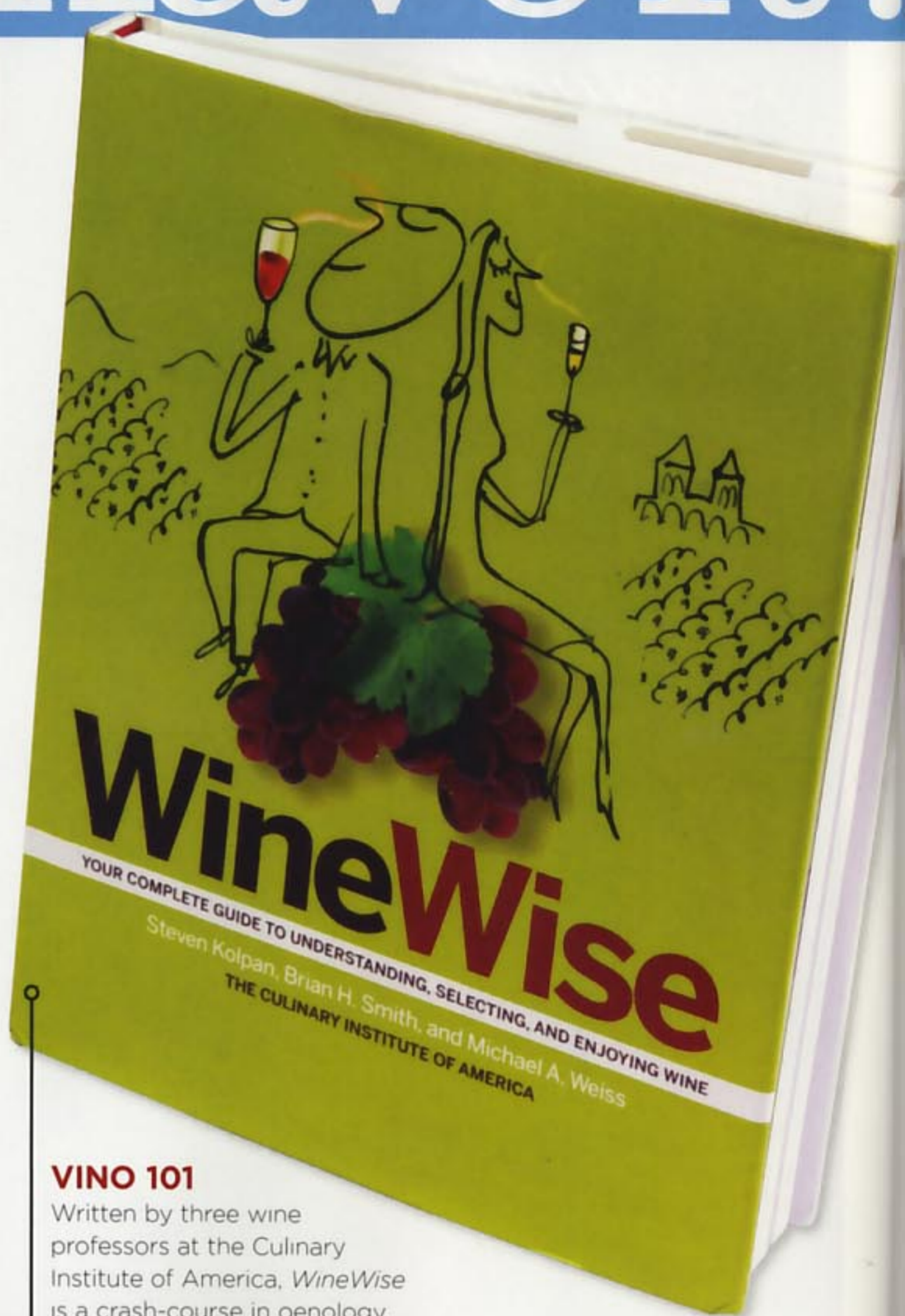
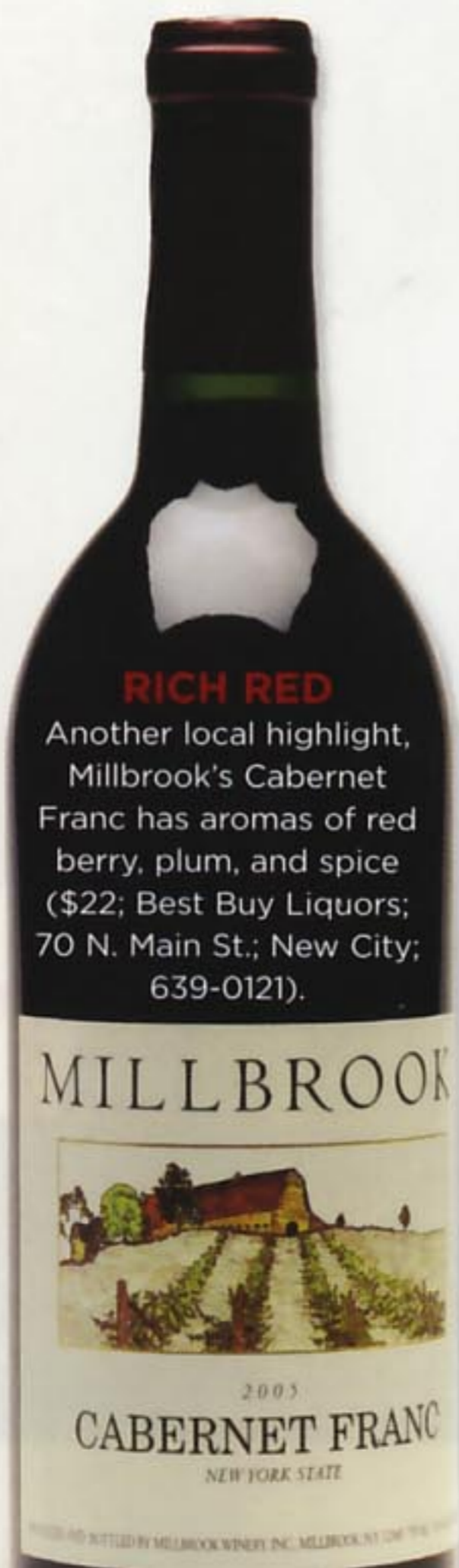
WHITE NECTAR

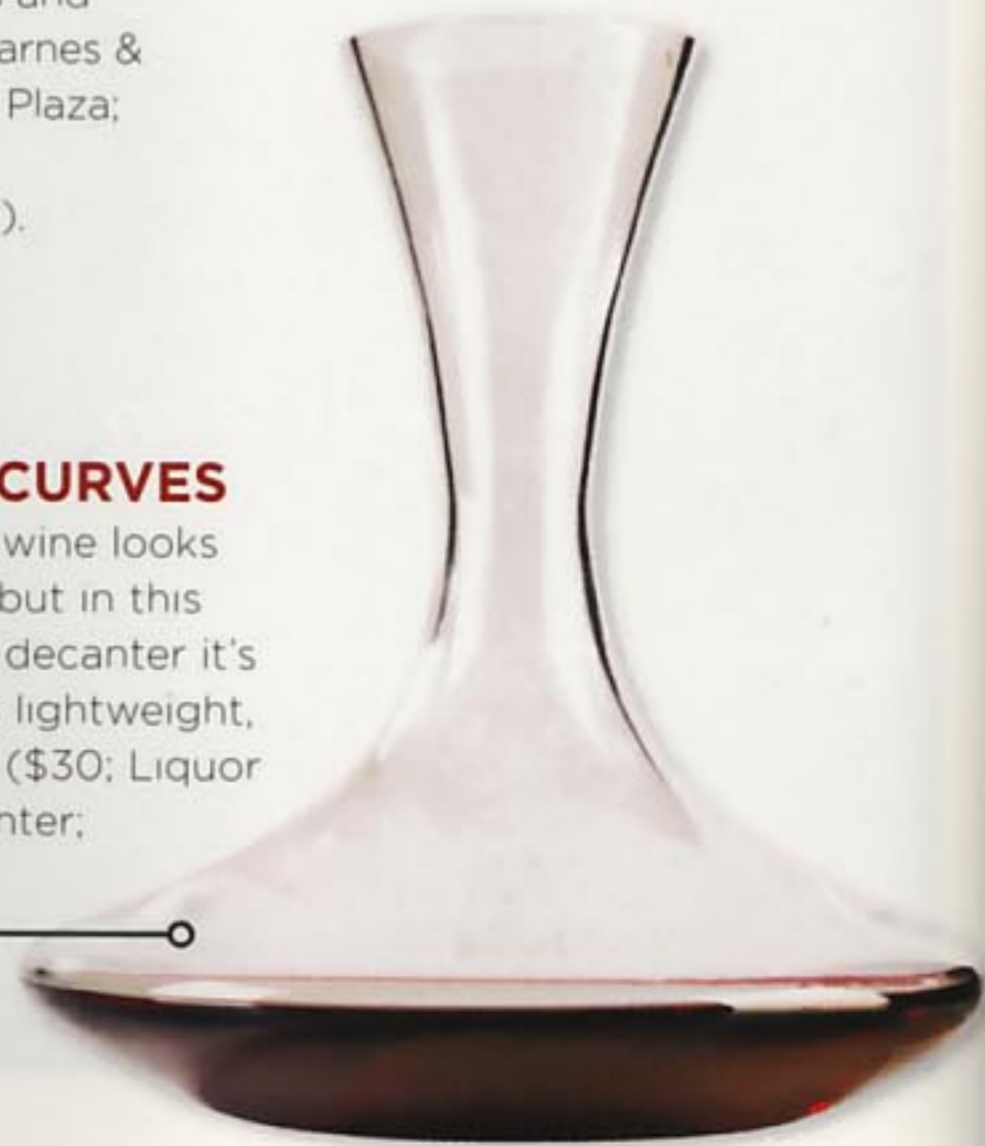


VINO 101
